Raj Kumar Srivastava** visited on Thursday, 26 November 2020, Faculty of Electrical Engineering and Computing, University of Zagreb, where he was received by the Dean of FER, **prof. dr. sc. Gordan Gledec**, vice dean for science, **prof. dr. sc. Nikola Miskovic**, the director of the Innovation Center Nikola Tesla, **prof. emer. dr. sc. Nedjeljko Perić** and **prof. dr. sc. Darko Žubrinić** from the Department of Applied Mathematics.



The Ambassador of India was accompanied by the Second Secretary for Political, Economic and Consular Affairs, Hemant Kumar Pandey, and the Public Relations and Culture Adviser, Ivan Delic.

The meeting discussed the **position and importance of FER** in the academic and scientific research community and its positioning at the international level. Special emphasis was placed on **strengthening bilateral cooperation with universities in India**, primarily in the form of exchanges of students and research and teaching staff.

Ivan Petrović and the Laboratory for Renewable Energy Systems (LARES), where the Indian delegation was hosted by prof. dr. sc. Mario Vašak.
