# PART I: INDIAN ECONOMY

## **News Features**

1. **Conference of Parties to the Convention on Migratory Species:** Mr. Tomislav Ćorić, Croatian Minister for Environment and Energy, accompanied by a large delegation, participated in the 13th Meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Convention on the Conservation of Migratory Species of Wild Animals

(CMS COP 13) held from 15-22 Feb 2020 at Gandhinagar, India. At the Conference, delegates, non-governmental organizations, and intergovernmental organizations discussed priorities for migratory species conservation in the Post-2020 Global Biodiversity Framework, highlighting the importance of connectivity in tackling the unprecedented threats facing migratory species. At the Conference, Mr. Corić pointed to connectivity solutions in Croatia and stressed that the Post-2020 Global Biodiversity Framework must include strict goals and numbered targets in order to be successful.

2. Indian businessman to invest €50 million in Petrinja: Indian businessman Mr. Arvind Kapur signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Petrinja Mayor Darinko Dumbovic, which envisages up to €50 million investments in agriculture in the Petrinja area. Mr.Kapur, who is also the owner of a pizzeria chain and the director of Capitel Group, an investment and technology company, has expressed his interest in


growing hazelnut, walnut and chestnut plantations in Petrinja. He expressed hope that the investment would be profitable because Indians have a long tradition and much experience in agricultural production. He said that he could offer good technologies and processes in agricultural production.

3. **DefExpo in Lucknow:** Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated the11th edition of DefExpo which was held in Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh. DefExpo has become one of India's largest defence exhibition platform as well as one of the top DefExpos in the world. At Defexpo-2020, more than a thousand defence manufacturers and 150 companies from all over the world participated. Over

200 partnerships involving signing of Memorandum of Understanding (MoUs), Transfer of Technology (ToTs), Product launches were also concluded during DefExpo 2020.

4. **India became second largest steel producer of crude steel:** According to the World Steel Association data, India became the second largest steel producer of crude steel after China in 2018 and 2019, by replacing Japan. India's crude steel production in 2018 was







at 109.3 MT, an increase of 7.7% from 101.5 MT in 2017. Steel being a deregulated sector, the Indian Government does not set any annual targets for steel production. Decision on quantity of steel production is taken by individual companies based on commercial considerations and market requirements.

## Industry

According to Indian Central Statistics Office (CSO) data, India's Index of Industrial Production rose 2% in January 2020 over a year earlier.

## Foreign Direct Investment (FDI)

According to the Department for Promotion of Industry and Industrial Trade (DPIIT), during the first half of the 2020-21 financial year, FDI into India increased by 15% and reached US\$ 26 billion. During April-September 2019-20, the maximum foreign inflows were in sectors, that include services (US\$ 4.45 billion), computer software and hardware (US\$ 4 billion), telecommunications (US\$ 4.28 billion), automobile (US\$ 2.13 billion) and trading (US\$ 2.14 billion). The foreign investment norms were relaxed recently by the Government in sectors such as brand retail trading, coal mining and contract manufacturing.

## **Inflation**

Indian Central Statistics Office (CSO) data showed that the retail inflation fall to 6.58% in February 2020, compared with 7.59% in January 2020, due to moderating food prices.

## PART II: INDIA-CROATIA ECONOMIC RELATIONS

#### News Features

1. **Lecture at Diplomatic Academy:** Ambassador Arindam Bagchi made a presentation on 'India's Foreign Policy in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century' at Diplomatic Academy in Zagreb and briefed the future diplomats on Indian diplomacy and India-Croatia relations. The lecture was attended by appx. 50 participants followed by enthusiastic Q&A.







3. **Meetings with other business leaders:** During the month, meetings were held with several business leaders in sectors of finance, film, construction, etc.

## **Bilateral Trade**

In 2019 (for which local statistics are available) the total bilateral trade stood at Euro 149.31 million, i.e. India's exports worth Euro 109.50 million and India's imports worth Euro 39.81 million.
