# PART I: INDIAN ECONOMY

# News Features

1. **Indian railway solarised more than 960 stations:** Indian Railways solarised more than 960 stations till date to achieve its objective of becoming 100% self-sustainable for all its power needs and to contribute to national solar power goals. Also, orders have been placed for 198 MW solar rooftop capacity for 550 stations which are under execution. The use of solar power will accelerate the Railways' mission to achieve the goal of

becoming 'Net Zero Carbon Emission Railway'. In order to achieve this, Indian Railways has developed a mega plan for installing solar plants of 20 GW capacity by utilizing its vacant land by 2030. Some of the Stations solarised are Varanasi, New Delhi, Old Delhi, Jaipur, Secunderabad, Kolkata, Guwahati, Hyderabad, Howrah etc.

2. India's electronic exports may rise to \$180 billion by 2025: According to the Electronics and Computer Software Export Promotion Council (ESC) data, electronics exports from India may potentially hit \$180 billion by 2025 from just \$11.28 billion in 2019-20. With global supply chain for electronic goods witnessing a restructuring as companies look to reduce

dependence on China, India's domestic electronic goods industry is staring at a potential windfall.

3. India jumped ranked 48 on Global Innovation Index 2020: India jumped four places to rank at 48th position at the 2020 edition of the Global Innovation Index (GII). The index, compiled by World Intellectual Property Organisation (WIPO) along with Cornell University and the INSEAD business school, presented

the latest global innovation trends and annual innovation ranking of 131 economies. Moving up four positions since last year, India became the third most innovative lower middle-income economy in the world. India ranks in the top 15 in indicators such as ICT services exports, government online services, and R&D-intensive global companies.

4. **Online grocery to become \$18 billion industry in India by 2024:** According to a joint initiative study by Bengaluru-based market research company RedSeer and Bigbasket (Brand Intelligence), online food is going to be the next battlefield for growth, growing to over \$18 billion by 2024. The report found that after the pandemic, demand for comfort foods such as noodles

and cookies, immunity boosters such as lemon and hygiene items such as sanitizers picked up while essentials stayed high.

## **Industry**

According to Indian Central Statistics Office (CSO) data, India's industrial production contracted for the sixth consecutive month in August due to lower output of manufacturing, mining, and power generation sectors. The Index of Industrial Production contracted 8% in August 2020 compared to a year ago.

### Foreign Direct Investment (FDI)

India's FDI regime is the most liberal in the world, and even during the COVID-19 pandemic, the country has attracted over US\$ 22 billion worth of direct investments. Almost 90% of the US\$ 22 billion foreign direct investment in India during the pandemic came through the automatic route.

# **Inflation**

Indian Central Statistics Office (CSO) data showed that India's retail inflation rose to 7.34% in September 2020 amid rising prices of essential kitchen items.

### **Bilateral Trade**

In the period from Jan-July 2020 (for which local statistics are available) the total bilateral trade stood at Euro 86.52 million, i.e. India's exports worth Euro 77.64 million and India's imports worth Euro 8.88 million.
