Today marks 365 days since India assumed the G20 Presidency. It is a moment to reflect, recommit, and rejuvenate the spirit of 'Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam, 'One Earth, One Family, One Future.'

As we undertook this responsibility last year, the global landscape grappled with multifaceted challenges: recovery from the Covid-19 pandemic, looming climate threats, financial instability, and debt distress in developing nations, all amid declining multilateralism. In the midst of conflicts and competition, development cooperation suffered, impeding progress.

Assuming the G20 Chair, India sought to offer the world an alternative to status quo, a shift from a GDP-centric to human-centric progress. India aimed to remind the world of what unites us, rather than what divides us. Finally, the global conversation had to evolve - the interests of the few had to give way to the aspirations of the many. This required a fundamental reform of multilateralism as we knew it.

The opening ceremony of the Croatian 45 International Book Fair - Interliber 2023, the largest literary event in Croatia with more than 300 exhibitors from 13 countries was opened on the 7th November by H.E. Mrs. Phd. Nina Obuljen Koržinek, Minister of Culture and Media with inaugural speeches by Amb Vikas Swarup & Ambassador Srivastava, Ms Renata Suša, Director of Zagreb Fair and Mr. Tomislav Tomašević, Mayor of the City of Grad Zagreb. The special guest of this year's Interliber, the author Vikas Swarup: "Books are much more than ink on paper, they connect us through time and space. They are bridges to the past, maps to the present, and guides to the future. We celebrate the written words here". Find Amb Swarup statement here.



Ambassador Srivastava pointed out that the 30 chapters in the recently published book, would be expanded exponentially in the next decade driven by people-to-people ties as Croatia and India has convergence in Democracy, complementarity in Demography, and commonality in Diversity. Among those new chapters, one would surely be on Books & Authors the beginning of which is taking place today in Interliber. The Book Fair in India next year would hopefully have Miro Gavran from Croatia. The director of Zagreb Fair, Renata Suša, assessed that Interliber has long gone beyond the limits of the Zagreb Fair. She added that her goal is to connect all stakeholders of the publishing industry: readers, institutions, publishers, the cultural and economic sector, and the media, with the desire for further development and qualitative growth of the country's central literary event. Mayor Tomašević said in the introduction that Interliber is not only a traditional autumn gathering of book lovers, but also the largest and most prestigious book fair in Croatia and the region, and one of the most important cultural events in Croatia. Minister Obuljen Koržinek mentioned that the translation of International books is important for the future and officially opened the 45th edition of Interliber.

"The Talk: Vikas Swarup"

The 45th Interliber witnessed a 2-hour-long literary event "The Talk: Vikas Swarup" moderated by Croatian writer Jasen Boko. During the event in front of around 200 participants, Amb Swarup pointed out his views on his first novel "Q&A" which was translated into 50 languages and won the Prix Grand Public at the Paris Book Fair and the South African Boeke Prize. Amb Swarup mentioned that books enabled him to see the world in his childhood when he did not see the world outside of India. "As a child, I never set foot outside India, but books allowed me to have different experiences. Through books, we bridge differences in cultures, they open a view into the totality of human experience", he said, adding that book fairs like Interliber are "proof of the resilience and modernity of books". "Croatia is a good example of a country that values reading. Interliber is an indicator of the democracy of the imagination," he said. After the event, Amb Swarup signed the books for the book lovers of Interliber. The book "Q&A" was translated by Vladimir Cvetković Sever and published by Znanje in 2023. The author's second novel "Six Suspects" was also translated into the Croatian language in 2013. The event was attended by Ambassador Srivastava, Ms. Renata Suša, Director of the Zagreb fair, Mr. Zvonimir Čimić, Director of the publishing house Znanje and Ambassadors from the Czech Republic and Italy.



New India at work in diverse sports arenas



World Cup 2023 in India sets all-time tournament attendance record of 1.25 million



The just-concluded Cricket World Cup attracted a tournament-record 1.25 million spectators during the six-and-a-half-week event, which ended Sunday with Australia beating India by six wickets for its sixth title. The International Cricket Council said Tuesday that the tournament had 1,250,307 spectators. With six games to go, the spectator figures had already surpassed the one million mark. The India attendance figures surpass the earlier marks of the 2015 World Cup held in Australia and New Zealand, which attracted 10,16,420 spectators and the 2019 edition in England and Wales, which had 7,52,000 fans. The 10-team tournament in India saw each team play the others once to advance to the semi-finals. There were 48 matches played overall for a total average attendance of about 26,000. It was the 13th edition of the World Cup, with the first being held in 1975. ICC Head of Events Chris Tetley said the one-day international (ODI) tournament had been a "great success." Source.

India's Digital Economy Soars, Targets 20% GDP Share by 2025-26: MoS Rajeev Chandrasekhar. In a statement at the Global AI Summit hosted by Britain, Minister of State (MoS) for Electronics and Information Technology, Rajeev Chandrasekhar, highlighted India's remarkable digital transformation over the past eight years. The MoS emphasized that India has significantly increased its digital economy's contribution to the total GDP from 4.5% to 11%, with a bold target of reaching 20% by 2025-26. Chandrasekhar stressed that the digital and innovation sectors are experiencing growth rates two to three times faster than the non-digital segments of the economy. "So for us, all things digital represent real bread and butter, real goals and real objectives and artificial intelligence is a kinetic enabler of the already accelerating digital economy, growth and governments", he said.



India's Healthcare Sector Poised for Tenfold Growth in Digital Transformation by 2030. India's healthcare industry is set to undergo a profound digital transformation, with a report by Boston Consulting Group (BCG) and B Capital forecasting a staggering acceleration from \$2.7 billion in 2022 to an estimated \$37 billion by 2030. This growth is attributed to rapid digitization, the rise of innovative healthtech platforms, strategic partnerships between startups and established firms, and favourable funding environments for viable business models, supported by government initiatives. One prominent trend shaping India's digital healthcare landscape is the widespread adoption of digital healthcare post-COVID-19. Patients and healthcare providers are increasingly comfortable with technology for healthcare interactions, marking a new era in healthcare consumption.



India Targets \$1 Trillion in Exports by 2030, Focusing on Electronics, Renewable Energy, and EVs. Director General of Foreign Trade, Santosh Kumar Sarangi, highlighted key areas for India to achieve its \$1 trillion merchandise exports goal by 2030. Electronics, renewable energy, IT hardware, and electric vehicles (EVs) are identified as pivotal sectors. Notably, India's smartphone exports surged to \$10.9 billion in FY 23, with an 88.9% YoY increase in smartphone exports to \$5.6 billion from April to August. The Production Linked Incentive scheme for IT hardware, featuring major brands like Dell, HP, and Lenovo, is expected to boost exports. The renewable energy sector and the growing EV industry are also seen as significant contributors to India's export growth. Sarangi emphasized the government's comprehensive approach, including a shift to value-added products in traditional sectors like tea, coffee, marine products, and food grains. In 2022-23, India's total exports reached \$776 billion, with goods accounting for \$453 billion.



India Sets Course to Transform Airports into Global Connectivity Hubs

India is formulating a national policy to transform its airports into major international hubs, providing seamless global connectivity to South Asia. This policy, pending cabinet approval, aims to establish regulations to streamline security and immigration procedures at airports, allocate international flight rights, and develop the necessary infrastructure. The objective is to position airports like Delhi as competitive transit hubs, comparable to global hubs, according to individuals involved in shaping the policy. In the case of Delhi Airport, which currently comprises three terminals, there are plans to connect them through a train system.



Croatia in India

"Here's how they spent time at the Delhi International Dance and Music Festival, one of the biggest folklore shows in the world"



The story of the departure of the Knights Association from Korčula Kumpanjija - Blato cronies to India began a little less than two years ago, when Ambassador Srivastava visited the oldest settlement on the island of Korčula, as part of the Matice Hrvatska Blato project. Fate, or coincidence, wanted the Ambassador to come across members of the VU Kumpanji from Blato rehearsing kumpanji, the island's oldest, fencing, chain dance made of colours, for the then 58th edition of the Folklore Show in Blato, the oldest in the Republic of Croatia, on Plokata. Ambassador Srivastava wasted no time, the people of Blaćan soon received an official invitation to India.

"The official invitation arrived at the end of August, for 11 days in India "Nevertheless, we decided to be brave, to accept the invitation and the great honour of representing Croatia in distant India, we embarked on an extensive organization for which we had very little time," recalled VU Kumpanji president Stjepan Bačić.

"Upon our arrival in New Delhi, we immediately performed at the show, which I can certainly call the world championship in the context of folklore. From Europe, we were the only ones and Romania, and professional societies from all over the world performed, from Kazakhstan, Vietnam, Canada, Panama to Russia. We must admit that we were the most impressive, which was confirmed by the biggest applause. After the performance, members of other associations took selfies with famous Indians, while we stood quietly in line until the captain gave the signal to move. We are guided by discipline and military cohesion, comrades. came from the military companies of our island from the distant past," explains Duke Nikola proudly.

Although the Kumpanjija from Blato is an amateur association, with a detailed approach to the organization they have shown an enviable level of professionalism. From the day of the decision until the departure, President Stjepan said that they spent three to four hours a day on preparations to present Croatia in the best possible way in India. Funds for the trip had to be secured, the president points out, for which he thanks the tourist boards of the county and Croatia, our county and the Ministry of Culture and Media, while the organizers Indian Council for Cultural Exchanges - ICCR were responsible for all expenses on Indian soil.
